VCASP is at the forefront of discussions with Government and funding and policy bodies, regarding issues affecting persons with ABI and the development of services to meet identified needs.

Criminal Justice Sub Committee

The CJSC provides a venue to identify ways to improve supports to individuals with ABI in contact with the criminal justice system.
